RULES AND REGULATIONS

Art. 1

Schedule: Tuesday, January 4, 2011 - 9.30 am - Heats;
- 3.30 pm - Heats and qualifying events;
Wednesday, January 5, 2011 - 9.30 am - Heats;
- 3.00 pm - Heats and qualifying events;
Thursday, January 6, 2011 - 9.15 am - Finals.

Venue: Montebelluna Town Pools " Chiara Giavi "
via delle Piscine, 20 - 31044 MONTEBELLUNA (TV)
25 - meter, 6 - lane pool

Jury:	The Jury will be provided by G.U.G. - F.I.N. (<i>FIN registered officials</i>).
Timing:	Electronic timing with touchpads will be provided by F.I.CR.
Start:	One.
Video	Giant screen with results and images in real time courtesy of Siteland - web solutions - and RC Systems.

Art. 2

Athletes:	All swimmers must be suitably registered athlete members of F.I.N., C.I.P. or other foreign swimming Federations for the 2010 - 2011 season.

Age groups:	" RAGAZZI " (males born in 1995 - 1996 - 1997) SWIMMERS (females born in 1997 - 1998)
	" JUNIORES " (males born in 1993 - 1994) SWIMMERS (females born in 1995 - 1996)
	" ASSOLUTI " (males born in 1992 and before) SWIMMERS (females born in 1994 and before)

Clubs can enter athletes of lower age groups in higher age groups.

To shift athletes from category "ragazzi" or "juniores" to category "assoluti", clubs from the Veneto region and outside the Veneto (however Italian) must submit their request directly by "portale C.R.V.".

Foreign clubs must notify the host society by fax or email prior to and no later than Saturday 18th December 2010.

To shift athletes from category "ragazzi" or "juniores" all the competing clubs, Italian and foreign, must submit their request to the host society by fax or mail prior to and no later than Saturday 18th December 2011.

Athletes born earlier than 1997 (males) and 1998 (females) and athletes not entitled to participate are not allowed to participate in this championship.

Art. 3

Participation:

- Each club can enter **two athletes per event**, per category.
- Each athlete can compete in a maximum of 3 events during the entire competition.

Athletes who scored the best 6 times in the age group “**juniore**s” and “**assoluti**” in the following **qualifying** events 50m Free, 100m Back, 100m Fly, 100m Free, 100m Breast are entitled to participate in the finals on Thursday morning. In the event there is a tie between two or more swimmers in the qualifying events, there will be a playoff.

No final events on Wednesday morning are foreseen for the age group “ragazzi”; these will compete in the “heats” and the first three athletes classified will be awarded prizes.

Art. 4

Clubs do not need to send swimmers' badges.

No registration will be accepted after December 31, 2010.

Withdrawals must be notified by 12 o'clock (noon), December 31, 2010.

Art. 5

A copy of the bank transfer must be faxed (0423 601692). Upon receiving this, a payment receipt will be sent to the club in question.

Reimbursements for absent athletes will not be made unless communicated by 31 December 2010.

A copy of the bank transfer must be presented upon registration by the organising secretary's office.

Note: - Foreign clubs may pay upon arrival in Montebelluna.

Art. 6

Awards to clubs:

- To the winner : TROPHY
- To the second - placed: CUP
- To the third - placed : CUP

Ranking by club: To establish ranking, the points scored in each individual final event (Wednesday, January 6, 2010) will be taken into account as follows:

- First place: 7 points;
- Second place: 5 points;
- Third place: 4 points;
- Fourth place: 3 points;
- Fifth place: 2 points;
- Sixth place: 1 point.

If there is a tie amongst athletes, points will be divide between them. Athletes from each club will be accredited with all points awarded for their placements.

To determine the final ranking, only the scores of the 4 athletes (male or female) with the most overall points will be considered.

The club with the most points gained as specified above will be proclaimed the winner.

In case of a tie, the club with the most number of first placements will win.

In case of a further tie, the club with the most number of second placements will win.

- Awards to athletes:
- All athletes will receive a special prize to remind them of the competition.
 - Medals and prizes in kind will be awarded to the athletes who came first, second and third in each event and age group.
 - Special prizes shall be assigned to:
 - o The best male and female performance in the " Ragazzi ", " Juniores " and " Assoluti " categories, points in the federation rankings (males - prize doctors Roberto and Andrea Montañó / females - prize doctor Massimiliano Fracasso);
 - Special prizes will be awarded to the first three athletes in the three Grand Final races (200m Free, 200m Medley & 400m Free)
 - see event program.

- Awards to coaches:
- The coaches of the clubs that came first, second and third will receive special awards, also in cash:
- € 1.000.00 (one thousand euro) to the trainer of the 1st placed club.
 - € 800.00 (eight hundred euro) to the trainer of the 2nd placed club.
 - € 500.00 (five hundred euro) to the trainer of the 3rd placed club.

Art. 7

- Changes:
- The two organizing clubs reserve the right to change the schedule and order of events as a result of unforeseeable circumstances and inform participating clubs in time.
- They also reserve the right to change the number of clubs that are entitled to participate in the competition.

Art. 8

- Liability:
- The organizing clubs do not accept liability for whatever may happen to swimmers, technicians, third parties and things, before, during and after the competition.

Art. 9

PROGRAM FOR REGISTERED C.I.P. ATHLETES - FIDIR

During the finals on Thursday, January 6, 2011 a demonstration will be held in a unified swim relay race with the participation of athletes from A.S.D Sport Life Onlus - Montebelluna swimming team and athletes from Nuoto Veneto Banca swimming team.
