GENERAL INFORMATION (1/2)



REGISTRATION

- Please register prior to the warm-up at the welcome-desk at the entrance to the swimming-hall (1 representative per club)
- Pay your entry fee in case you did not make a bank-transfer

ELECTRONIC ENTRANCE / WARDROBE / LOCKER SYSTEM

- The Stadthallenbad (pool) has an **electronic entry** and a **separated electronic locker management system**. To simplify the entrance into the swimming hall we decided to deactivate the electronic system.
- You will not be able to lock the wardrobe cabinets please take valuable belongings to the pool
- There are separate lockers for valuable belongings which can be operated with 2 EUR coins
- The WLSV shall not be held responsible if your belongings are stolen / become untraceable

ENTRANCE FOR SWIMMERS AND TRAINER

- Entrance is permitted Thursday 12:30 am and Friday, Saturday, Sunday 07:00 am.
- Please use the main entrance after registering at the welcome-desk and go downstairs through the changing area into the pool.
- We have a separate warm-up and cool-down pool (50m, 5 lanes). You will have the option to swim throughout the day
- Please note you will not be allowed to enter the pool area with street-clothing!

ENTRANCE FOR VISTORS (non swimmers)

- Entrance is permitted 15 minutes prior to warm-up
- Please use the entrance to the visitors area left from the main entrance (stairs leading one floor above)
- Please note you will not be allowed to enter the pool area with street-clothing!

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

 The welcome desk does NOT provide information on races, cancellation, timing, results etc. – this information can be obtained in the race office in the swimming-hall

DINNER

There are numerous restaurants around the pool area – we recommend to ask for the price first as some of the restaurants are quite expensive due to the closeby event-area of Stadthalle (largest event hall in Vienna).




LOCATION OF POOL

Unfortunately the station names have to be entered in German - these are:


"Flughafen Wien Bahnhof" for the airport and "Burggasse Stadthalle" for the pool








PUBLIC TRANSPORT FROM THE AIRPORT TO THE POOL (2/2)






Alternatively you can use the airportbus:

The bus is a direct connection from the airport to the trainstation "Westbahnhof" which is one undergroundstation away from the pool.





- NO free parking around the Stadthalle (pool)
- On working days (Friday) parking in Vienna is fee-bases with a maximum parking time of 2 or 3 hours
- There are NO signs indicating fee-based parking areas
- Around Stadthalle (pool) parking is feebased between 18:00 – 22:00 hours each day
- Park&Ride garages are available at the entrance to Vienna
